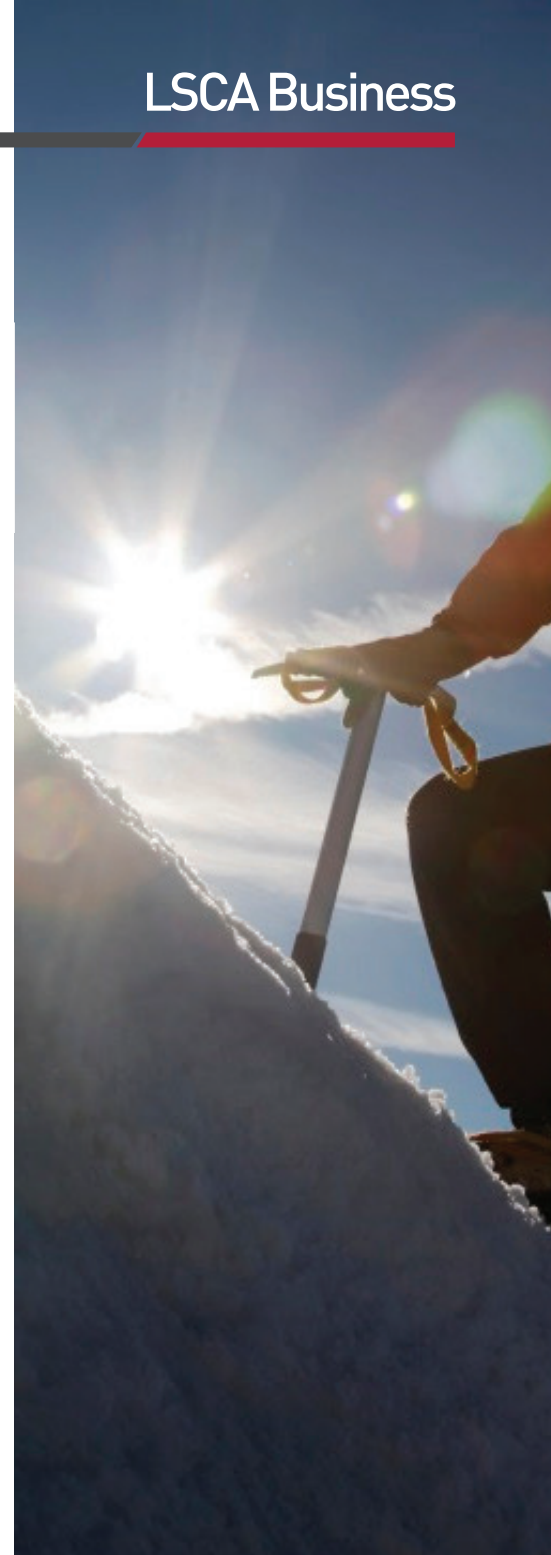
Lastly a call for volunteers !!
